

General Education Assessment Workshops

The Undergraduate Assessment Office offers three-part voluntary workshops to help faculty develop GER assessment materials. Workshop 1 provides background related to GER assessment and guides faculty in creating outcomes and identifying student assignments for measuring those outcomes. Workshop 2 focuses on changes in the [Course Action Form](#) and the [syllabus requirements](#) regarding GER assessment and leads faculty in making appropriate changes in both. Workshop 3 provides guidance in making sense of assessment data and in writing assessment reports. Each workshop, designed and delivered by Michael Carter, Associate Professor of English, runs for approximately two hours.
