

General Education Assessment Timetable For Review Cycle of Existing Courses:  
Draft to BE approved by CUE

- All proposals involving GER courses submitted on or after October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2003 are required to include documentation to meet the new GER requirements ([http://www.ncsu.edu/provost/academic\\_programs/courses/newcourseinst.html](http://www.ncsu.edu/provost/academic_programs/courses/newcourseinst.html)). Assessment reports of GER courses proposed on or after October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2003 will follow the same timetable for existing courses' report deadlines.
- Existing GER courses and their documentation, including revised course action forms and corresponding documentation and assessment reports, will be reviewed according to ([Phased Implementation Proposal](#)). Once continuous adjustments are made to the plan, the two timetables below will be followed. Assessment reports of existing courses will be due in September following the year that the revised course action form and documentation are due. The CUE will randomly select 25-50 courses from that year to review and provide feedback to the departments. Those courses with multiple sections can choose either to summarize assessment results for all sections or to summarize and report results from several randomly selected sections (e.g., one assessment report for each course, regardless of number of sections).
