

Dear NC-MSEN Pre-College Parent and Student:

We are looking forward to your child attending our Summer Scholars program from June 22 – 26 and July 6 – 10, 2009, Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. The Summer Scholars Program will take place in Harrelson Hall on June 22 and 23 and in Poe Hall on the other dates. Both of these buildings are located on the main campus of North Carolina State University.

The school day will be divided into classes in the morning and activities such as tours and local field trips in the afternoon. Students will each lunch daily in the Fountain Dining Hall on NCSU's campus. High school students will take three classes, Forensic Science, SAT Prep – Critical Reading and Writing, and Mathematics while our middle school students will take courses in mathematics, science, robotics, and technology. Each high school class will last one hour and 15 minutes, and the middle school students will last 50 minutes.

All students will be **required** to bring a notebook or binder with paper and pencil. For high school students, if they have a TI-83 plus or TI-84 calculator, please bring it. This is an academic program; therefore, students are expected to be prepared for learning each day. Due to the size of NC State University's campus, students should wear tennis shoes or comfortable walking shoes since students will have to walk considerably on a daily basis.

Cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed during classes, trips, tours, and guest presentations. Students may check their cell phones during lunch time, 12 – 1 p.m and at the end of the day. All electronic devices that are used during the day without permission will be taken by their teacher or MSEN staff, and parents will need to obtain the device back from the Coordinator.

On Friday, July 10, the last day, we will have a robotics competition during the last half of the day for the middle and high school students.
