Housing The graduate student participants are staying at the Bagwell Residence Hall. The presenters are staying at the Velvet Cloak Inn.

Meals For meals in the Fountain Dining Hall, the hours are 7:00 am until 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday. During the summer, campus dining halls are generally closed over the weekends.
