

Checklist for Dry Ice Shippers

This checklist should be used when shipping dry ice with non-hazardous materials. Do not ship your material if “NO” is checked for any of these entries.

Is the following correct for each entry?

Quantity

1. The quantity of the dry ice per package is 200kg or less

Packages and Overpacks

2. Packaging must be designed and constructed to permit the release of carbon dioxide gas and to prevent pressure build up.
3. Packages are free from damage and in proper condition for carriage
4. The packaging conforms to packing instruction 904 and the package is vented to permit the release of gas.

Markings

5. The words “Carbon dioxide, solid” or “Dry ice”
6. The UN number “UN 1845”
7. Full name and address of the shipper and consignee
8. The net quantity of dry ice within each package
