

## BRIEF BIOGRAPHY



**Julia Rice Mallette**, better known as Julie, became the Associate Vice Provost and Director of Scholarships and Financial Aid at NC State in July 2002. Julie joined the NC State family in April 1991 as the Associate Director of Financial Aid, and was promoted to Director in July 1992. As a veteran of her field, she brings over 24 years of financial aid administration to the Division of Enrollment Management and Services.

Julie's current responsibilities include managing a staff of twenty-seven employees, who are accountable for overseeing the distribution of over \$170 million in financial aid from federal, state, institutional, and private sources. This aid is distributed to almost 17,000 students annually.

Prior to joining NC State, Julie was the Assistant Director of Financial Aid at UNC-Chapel Hill (January 1985 - April 1991), and prior to that held Assistant Director and Financial Aid Counselor positions at UNC-Greensboro (December 1980 - January 1985). She has served as chair of the State Financial Aid Administrators Association's Program Committee, High School Relations Committee, and Legislative Advisory Committee. She has also served on the Program and Legislative Advisory Committees for the Southern Regional Financial Aid Administrators' Association. In addition, she served a three-year appointment to the College Board's Financial Aid Standards and Services Advisory Committee.

As a bona fide North Carolina native, Julie holds degrees from two UNC System institutions. She earned her bachelor's degree from UNC-Chapel Hill in English/Secondary Education; and she earned a master's degree in Counseling and Guidance from UNC-Greensboro. She has six brothers and sisters, all of whom have undergraduate degrees from UNC System institutions.
