



### **Erskine Bowles**

Erskine Bowles has served as president of the multi-campus University of North Carolina since January 1, 2006. He is a graduate of the University North Carolina at Chapel Hill and Columbia University's Graduate School of Business, and holds eight honorary doctorates from universities and colleges throughout America. Mr. Bowles began his business career at Morgan Stanley & Co. in New York as an associate in the corporate finance group. Upon returning home to North Carolina, he founded and served as chairman and CEO of the Charlotte-based investment banking firm that became Bowles Hollowell Connor & Co. Mr. Bowles also was a founder of Kitty Hawk Capital, a venture capital company, and Carousel Capital, a middle-market private equity company. In 1993, Mr. Bowles was appointed by President Bill Clinton to serve as director of the Small Business Administration, and later was tapped to serve as deputy White House chief of staff (1994-95) and White House chief of staff (1996-98).
