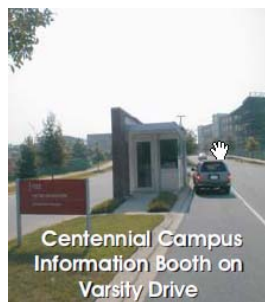
Directional Signage

When approaching a campus building, look for signs describing the direction of the nearest accessible entrance. An accessibility emblem is placed at all accessible entrance / exit doors throughout campus.



Inaccessible Building

General building signage is located near main building entrances identifying those facilities as inaccessible. For assistance, please contact the NC State ADA Coordinator. (Picture at left is not the actual signage in use)



Parking

Visitors may obtain a temporary parking pass: on North Campus at the Information Booth on Stinson Drive, on Centennial Campus at the Information Booth on Varsity Drive, or at the Transportation Department on the first floor of the Administrative Services Center I Building on Sullivan Drive. Please **DO NOT PARK** in reserved spaces without an appropriate parking permit.



Safety Escort

A safety escort is provided to all members of the University at any time, day or night, to any point on campus. To request a safety escort, contact Campus Police at (919) 515-3000, or use an Emergency Blue Light Telephone, which are positioned throughout campus for emergency assistance.



Transportation

NC State University's Wolfline Bus transportation system is accessible to persons with mobility impairments. Busses are equipped with lifts. Students, faculty and staff can ride the busses free of charge.
