

10400 Interior Signage

Part 1: General

- 1.01 Room Identification and Wayfinding - All campus facilities utilize a uniform methodology for numbering building rooms and spaces and must comply with a campus standard for interior signs and directories

Part 2: Design Guidelines

- 2.01 All building rooms and spaces shall be numbered consistent with NC STATE's room numbering methodology. See Section 00710 for additional information. Room numbers should be established during the Design Development stage consistent with this methodology and continued through Construction Document and Construction phases.
- 2.02 Interior signage should comply with NC STATE Interior Signage Standards. See the NCSU [Interior Signage Manual](#) for additional information on sign types, formats, and typology.
- 2.03 The designer shall meet with the NC STATE user group, and the FP&D Project Manager to develop the signage package during Construction Document development. During construction, the designer shall coordinate with the Construction Manager and the user group to re-verify the signage package prior to release for fabrication and installation.

- 1.01 All new building projects and major building renovations require the provisions for exterior signage
