

2005 Master Plan Update Implementation Strategy

Advisory Team

The role of the Advisory Team is to provide support, leadership, and representation to the campus and community for the Physical Master Plan update. The Advisory Team will provide feedback to the process and schedule proposed by the Office of the University Architect. The Team will also review drafts of the work from the Task Force Teams.

Precinct Workshops

The Workshops are a participatory, interactive session for each of the five Campus Precincts. A broad base of stakeholders in the precinct development will review and respond to current proposals in the Master Plan. Participants also will identify or reconfirm a vision for the neighborhoods within the precinct, list issues regarding growth and change, and establish a priority for physical growth to ensure a robust, vibrant campus Precinct.

West Precinct (including Centennial Biomedical Campus)

Central Precinct

Task Forces

Task forces will be appointed and charged by the Advisory Team and will be responsible for a specific part of the Physical Master Plan update and/or to prepare new additions to the plan. Task force membership will be broad based utilizing skills from faculty, staff, students and the community at-large as appropriate. The chairs of the Task forces will meet regularly to coordinate work.

Physical Environment Committee

The Physical Environment Committee (meeting monthly throughout the academic year) will receive timely updates on the Master Plan Process and will review, provide feedback, and make recommendations for support for the overall campus development plan including building sites, environment, and transportation.

Campus Design Review Panel

The Campus Design Review Panel (meeting monthly throughout the academic year) will receive timely updates on the Master Plan Process and will review, provide feedback, and make recommendations regarding design guidelines and standards and other master plan issues for support for the plan.

Board of Trustees

The Building and Property Committee of the BOT will review progress of the Master Plan Update and make recommendations to the full Board of Trustees, which ultimately, is responsible for the adoption of the Physical Master Plan revisions and updates.
