

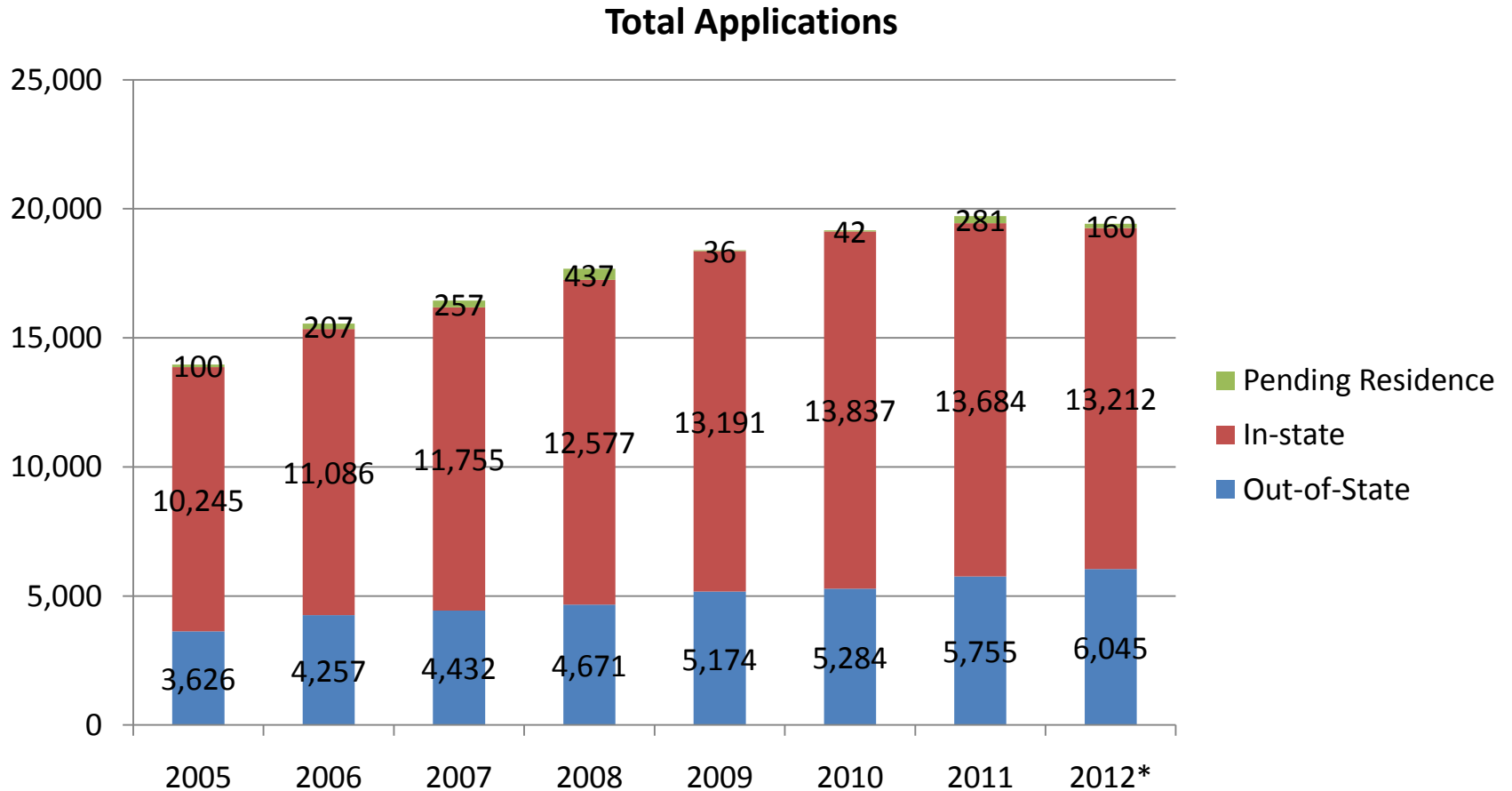

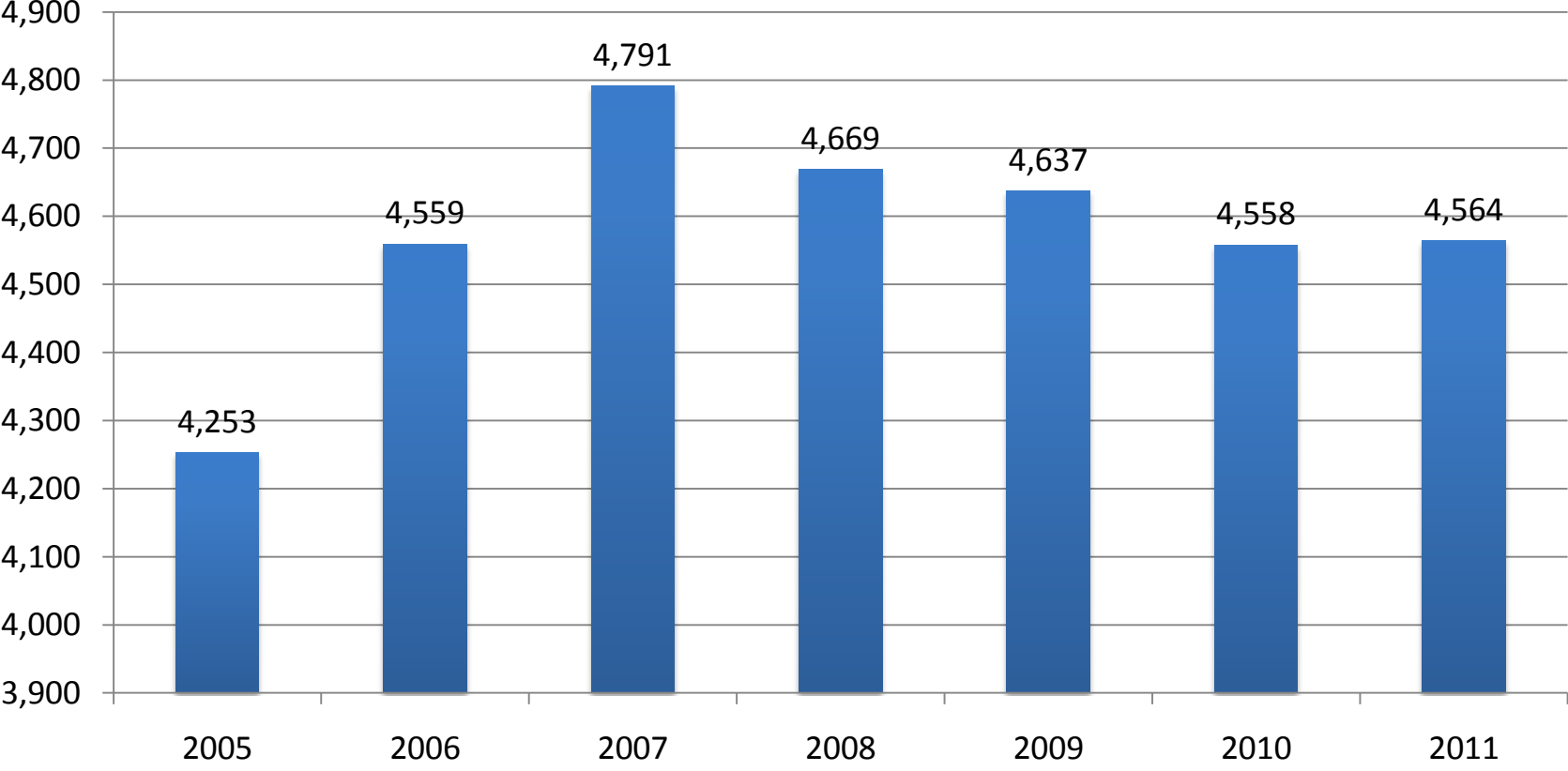

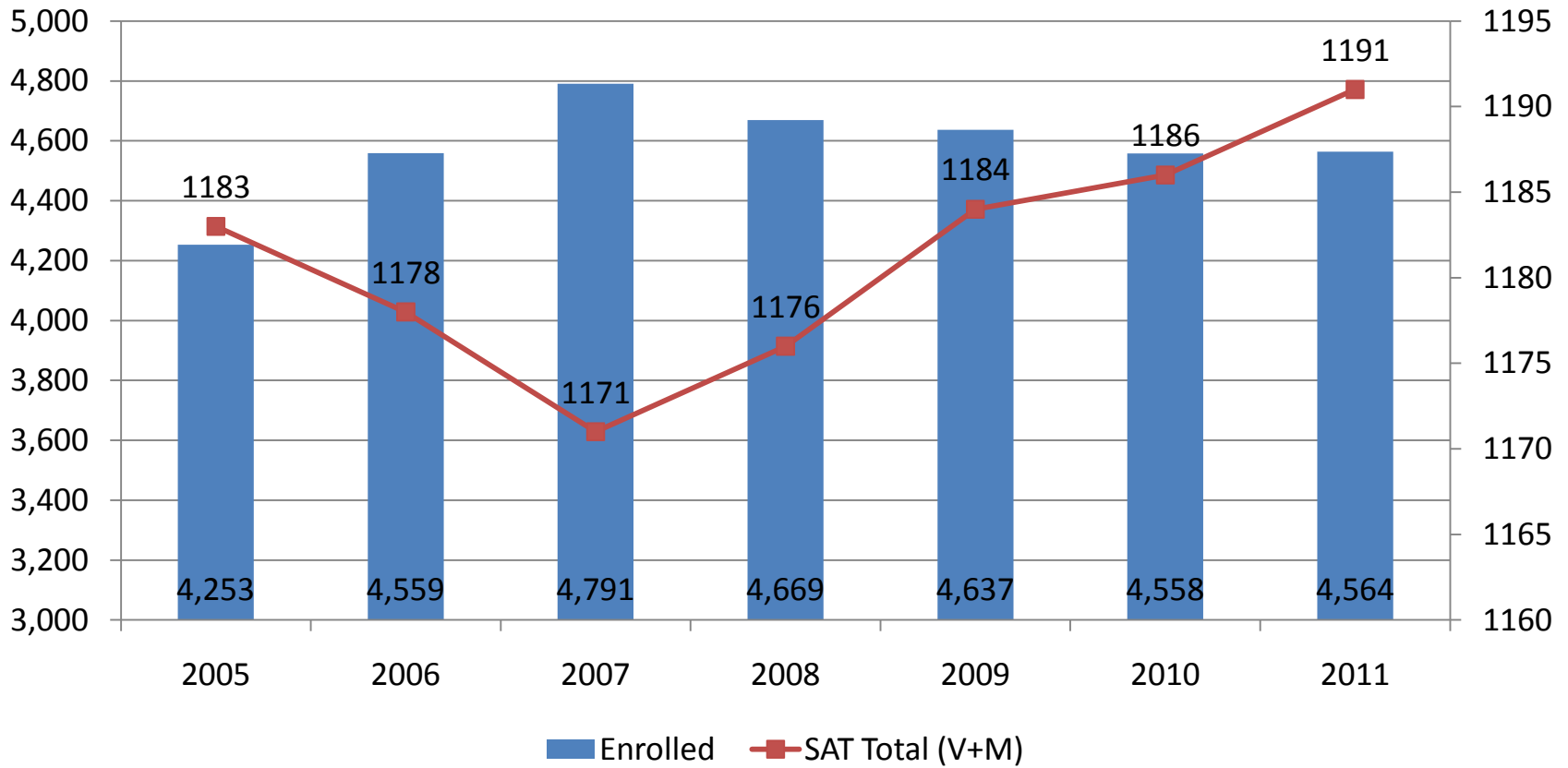

Enroll Total



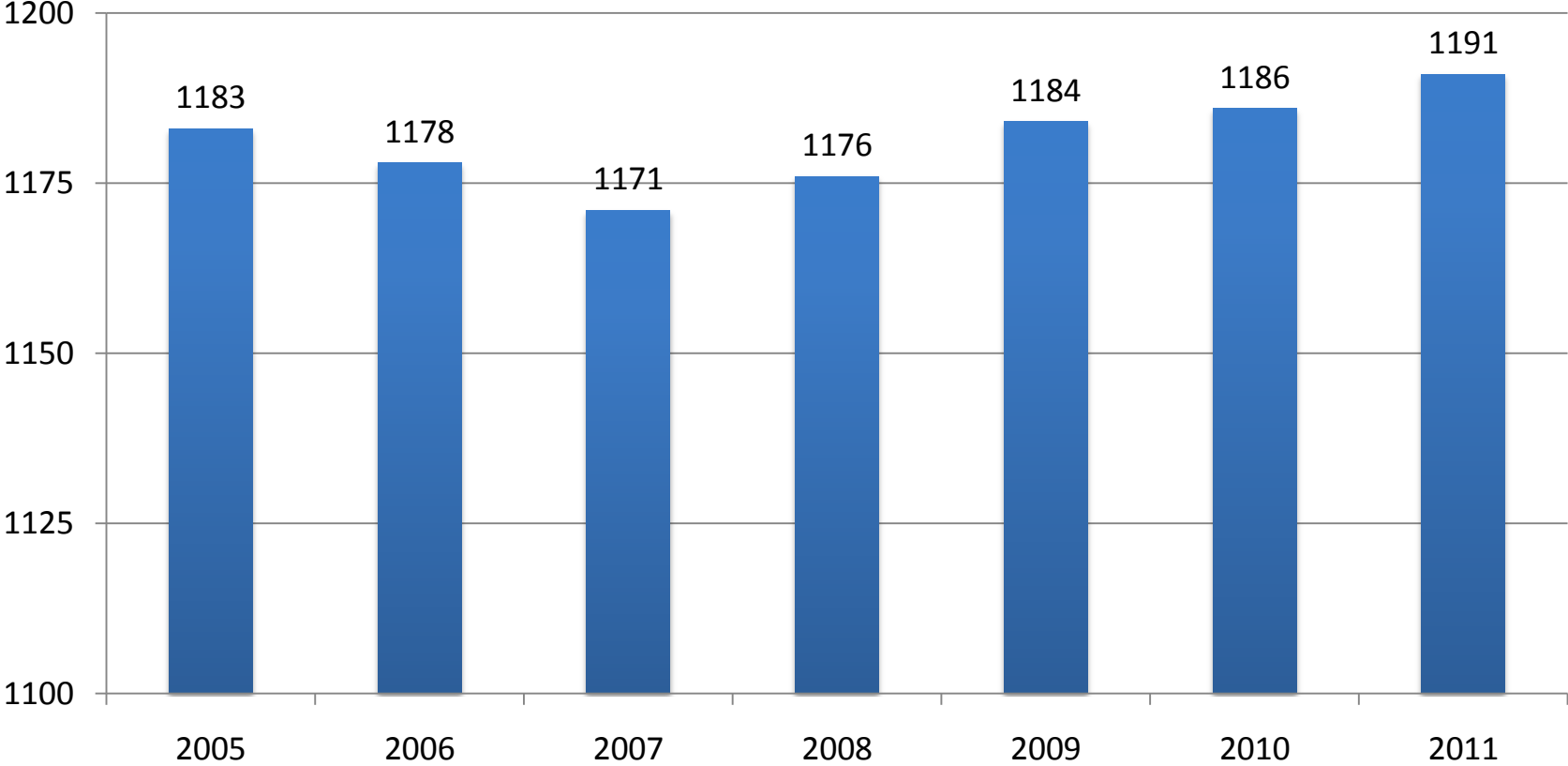

Enrollment vs. Total SAT



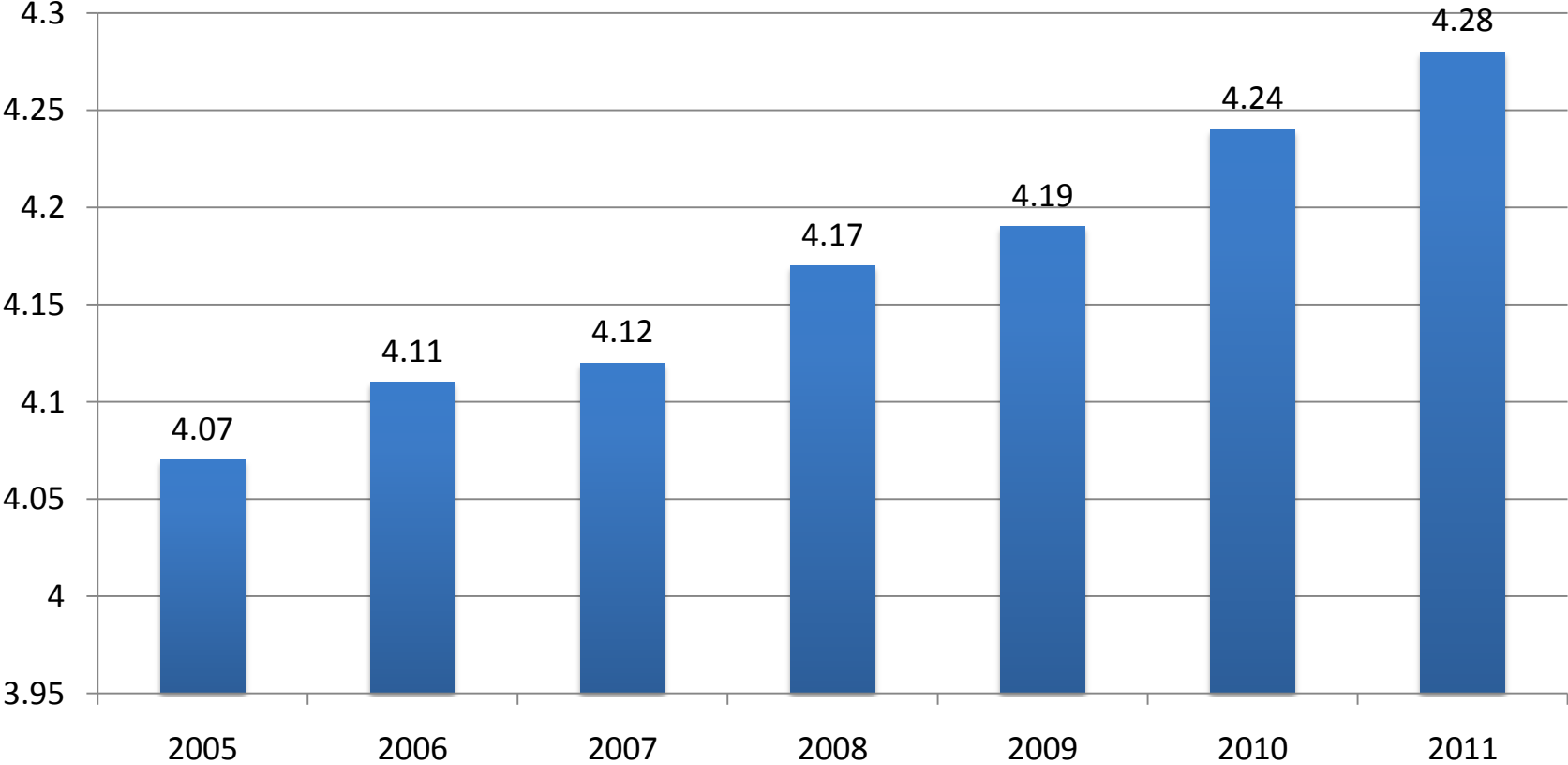

SAT Total (V+M)



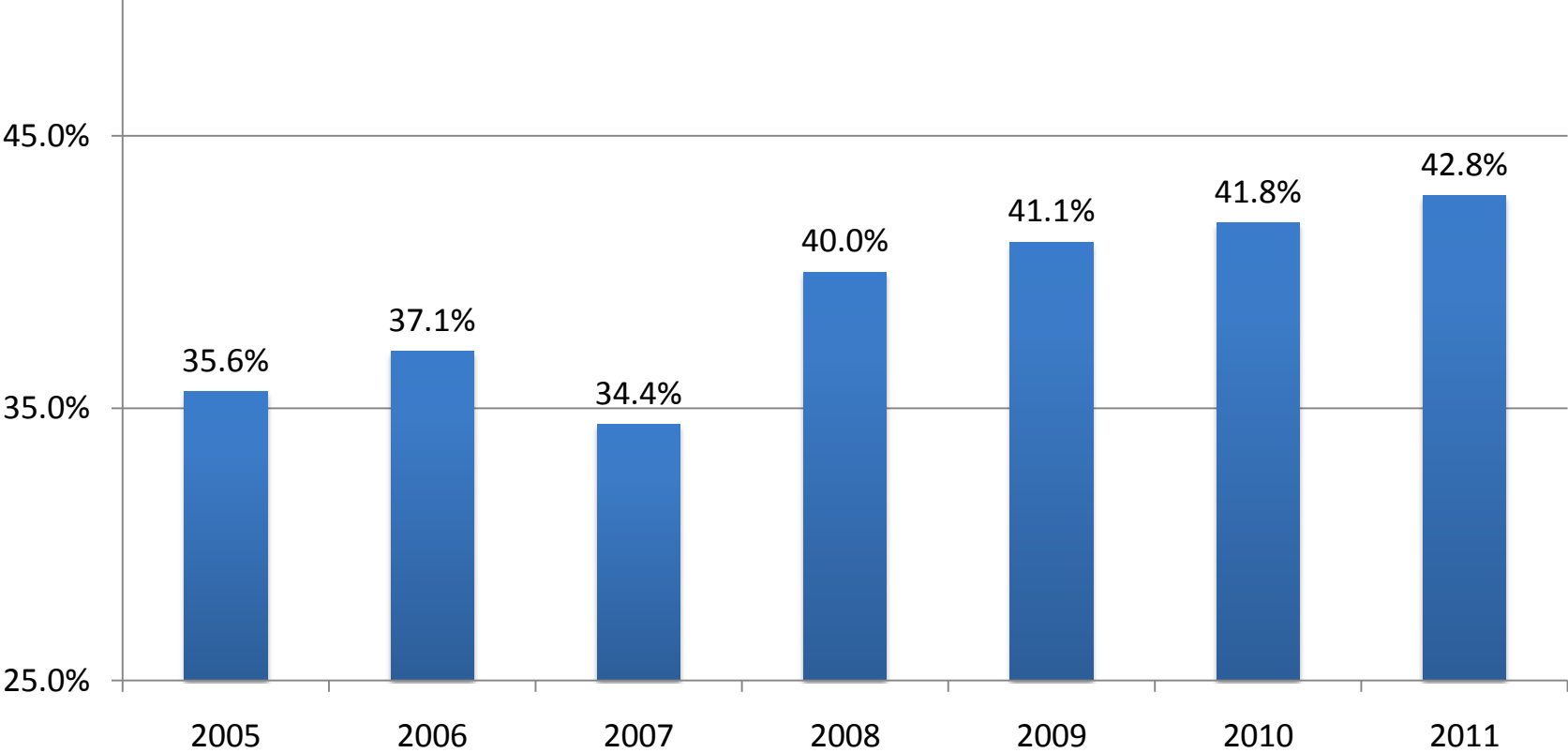

HS GPA



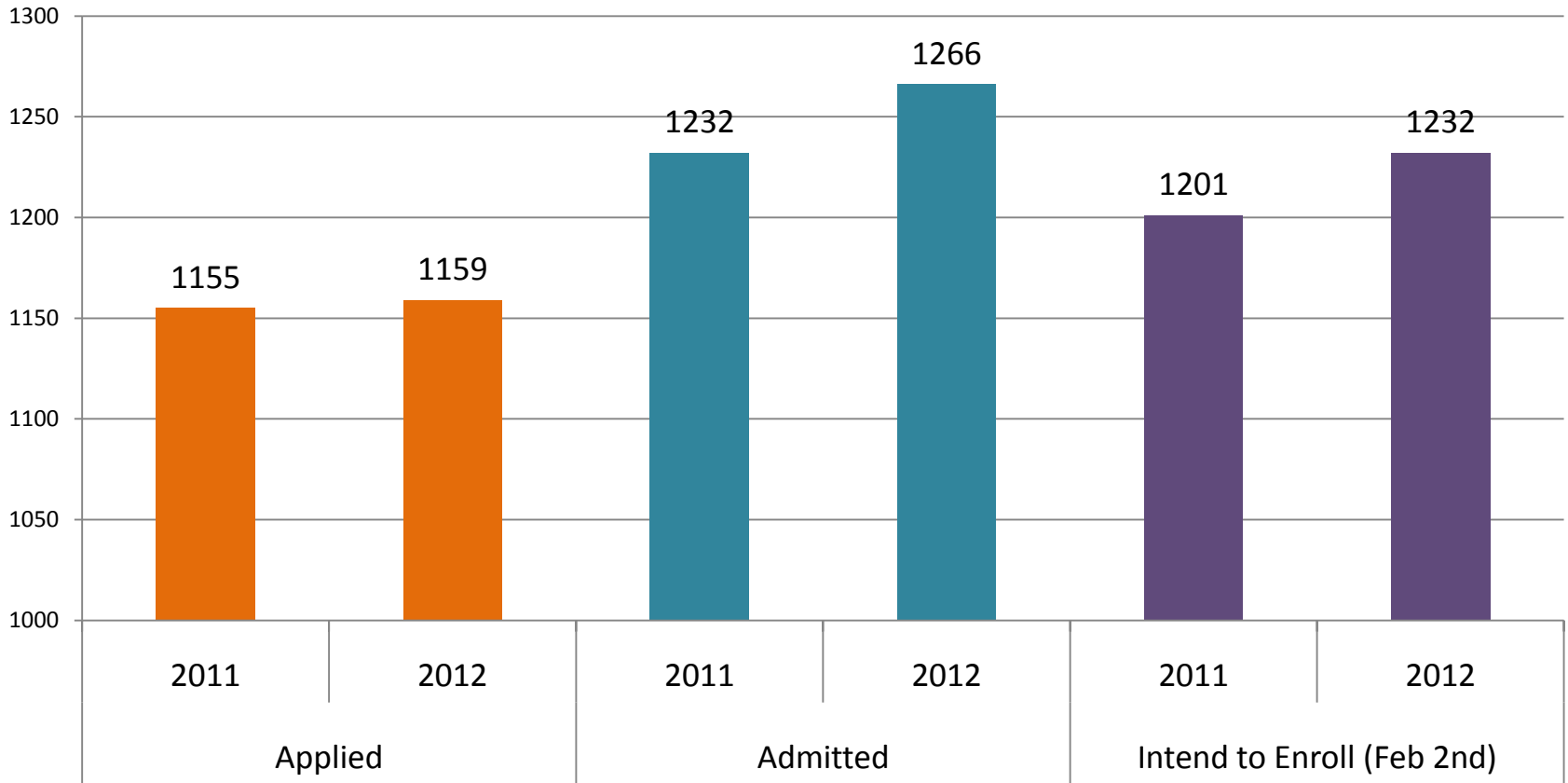

Pct in Top 10%



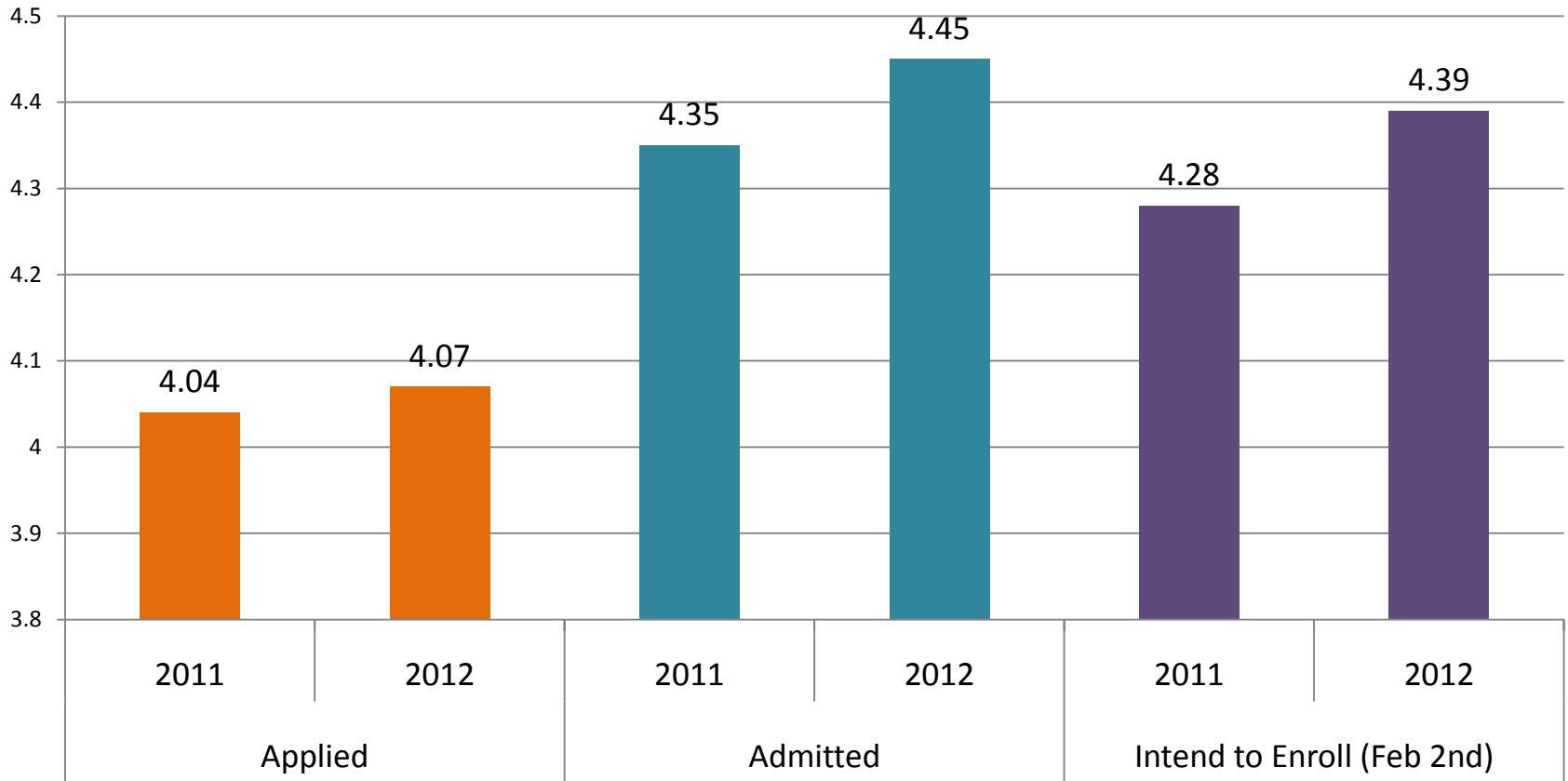
# 2011 vs 2012 NFR

Average SAT Total



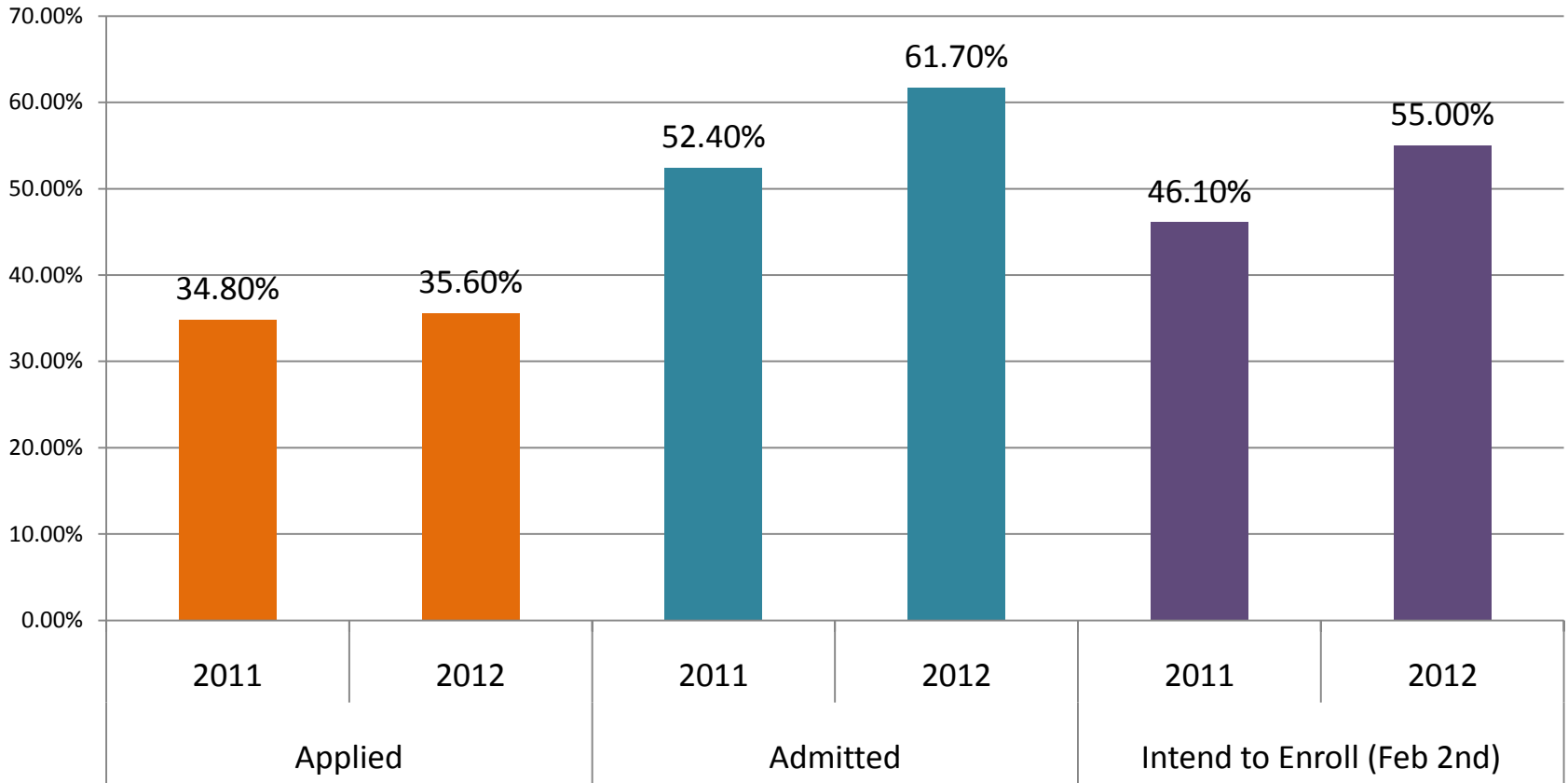
# 2011 vs 2012 NFR

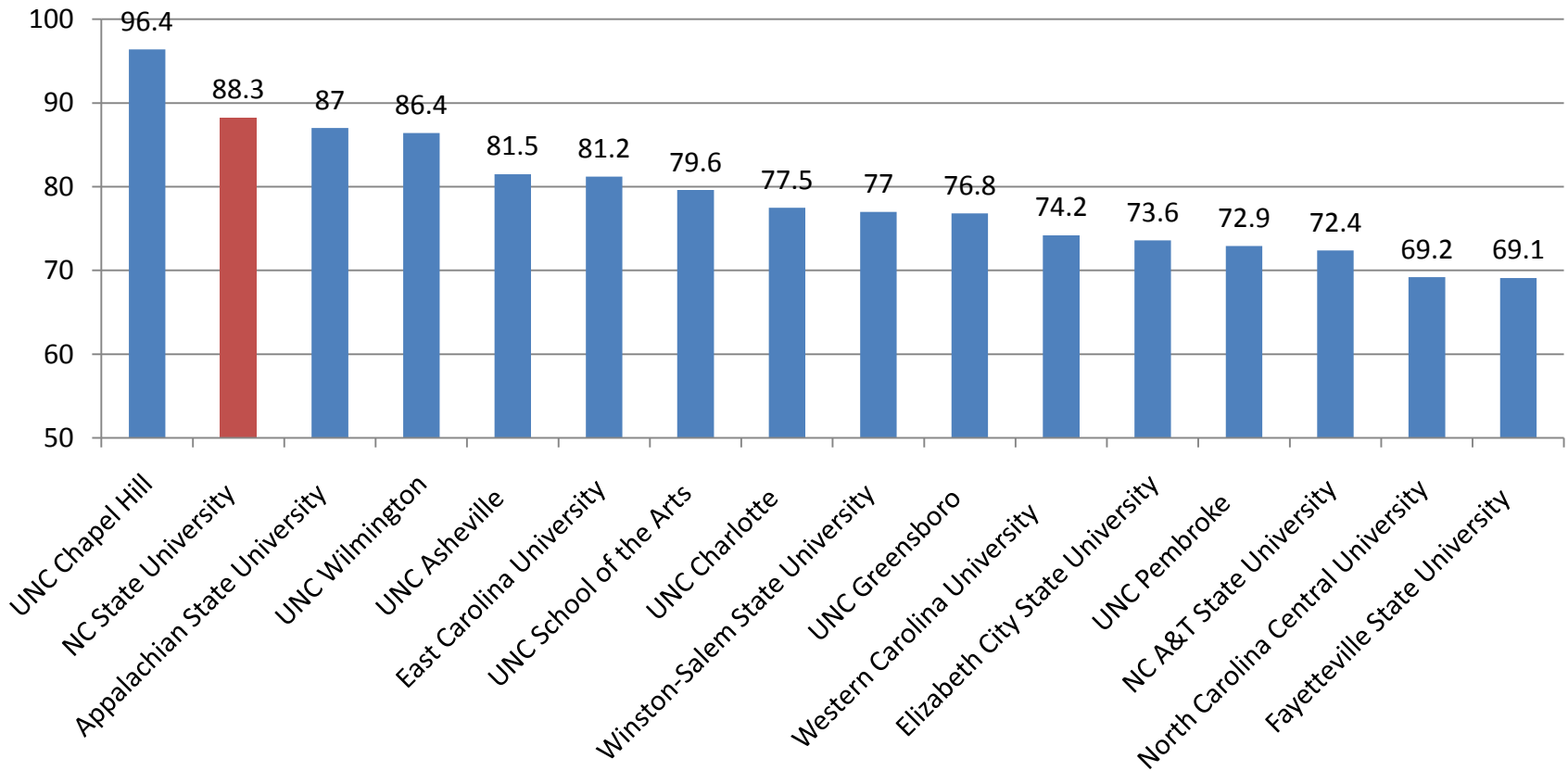
## Percent in Top 10% HS Rank



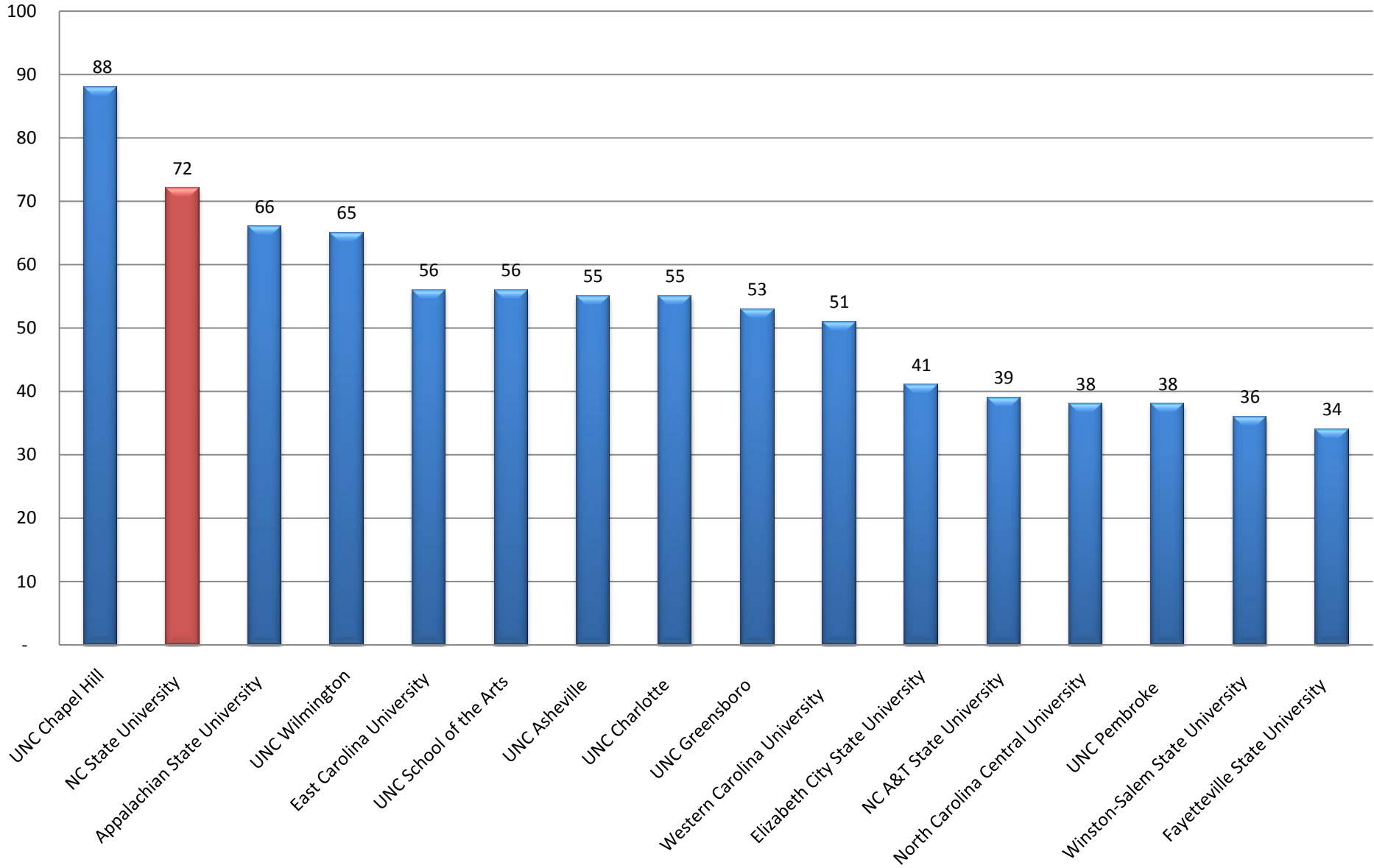

Retention After Year 1: UNC System Schools

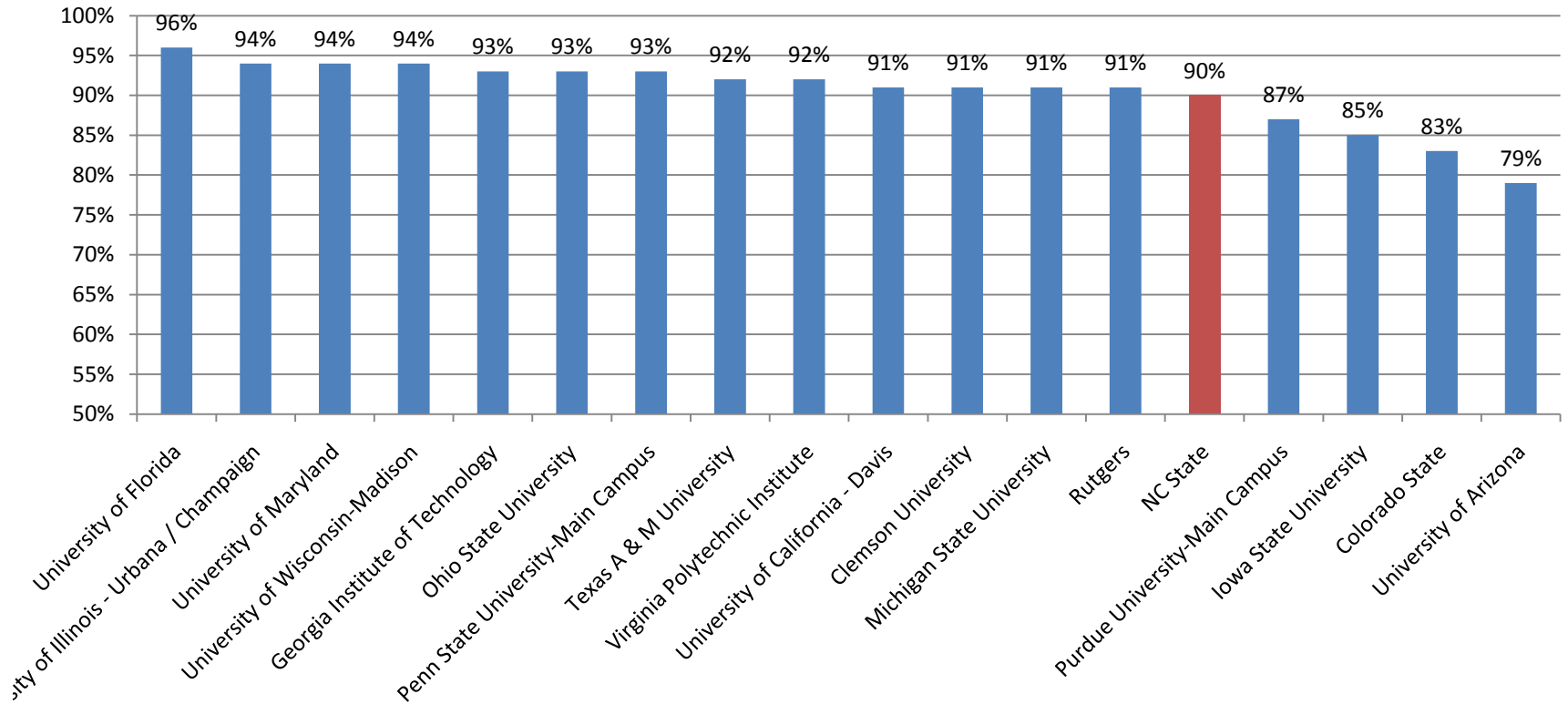


# 2004 Six Year Graduation Rate: UNC System Schools



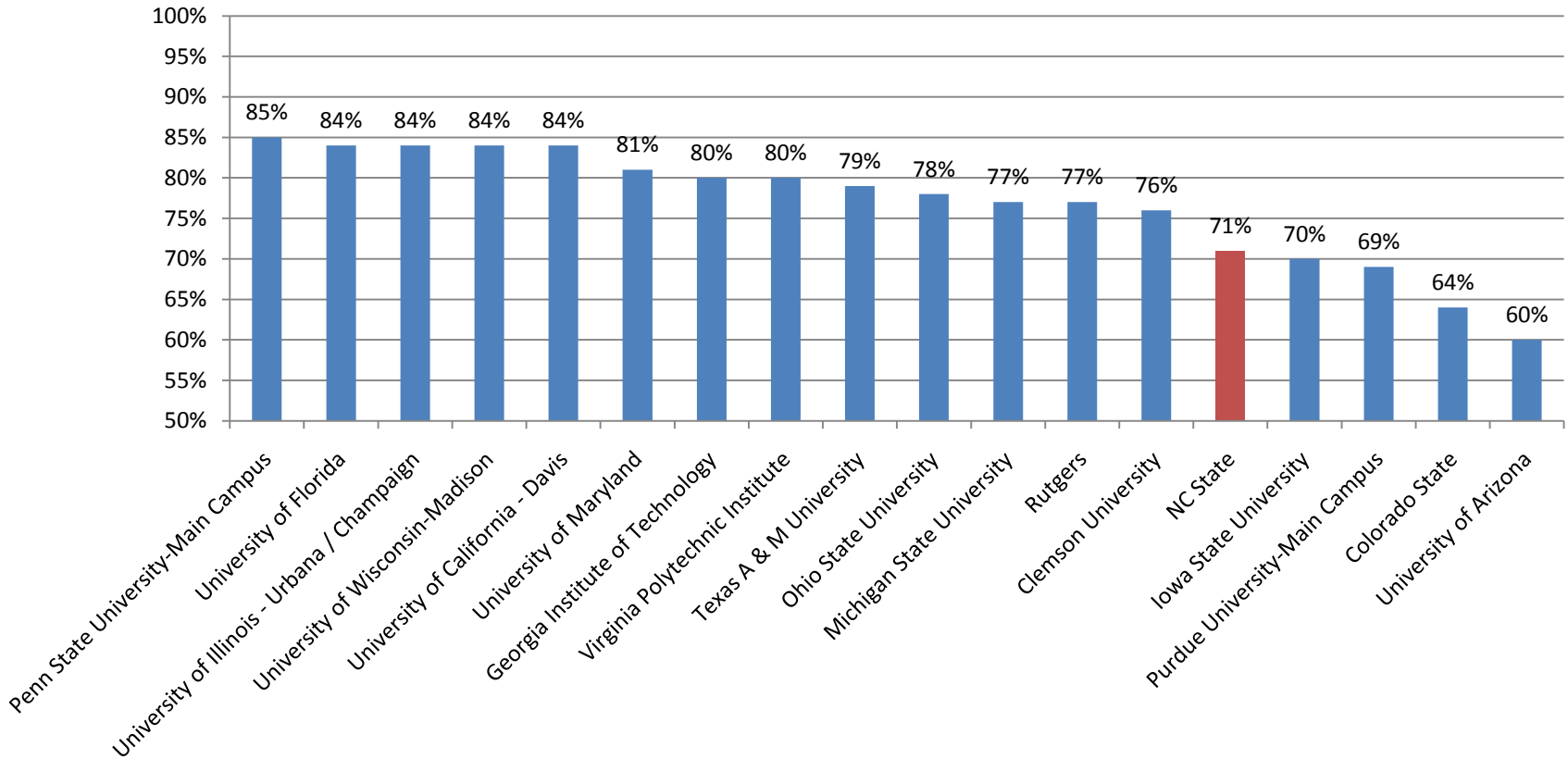
# Freshmen Retention

## Average Freshman Retention Rate

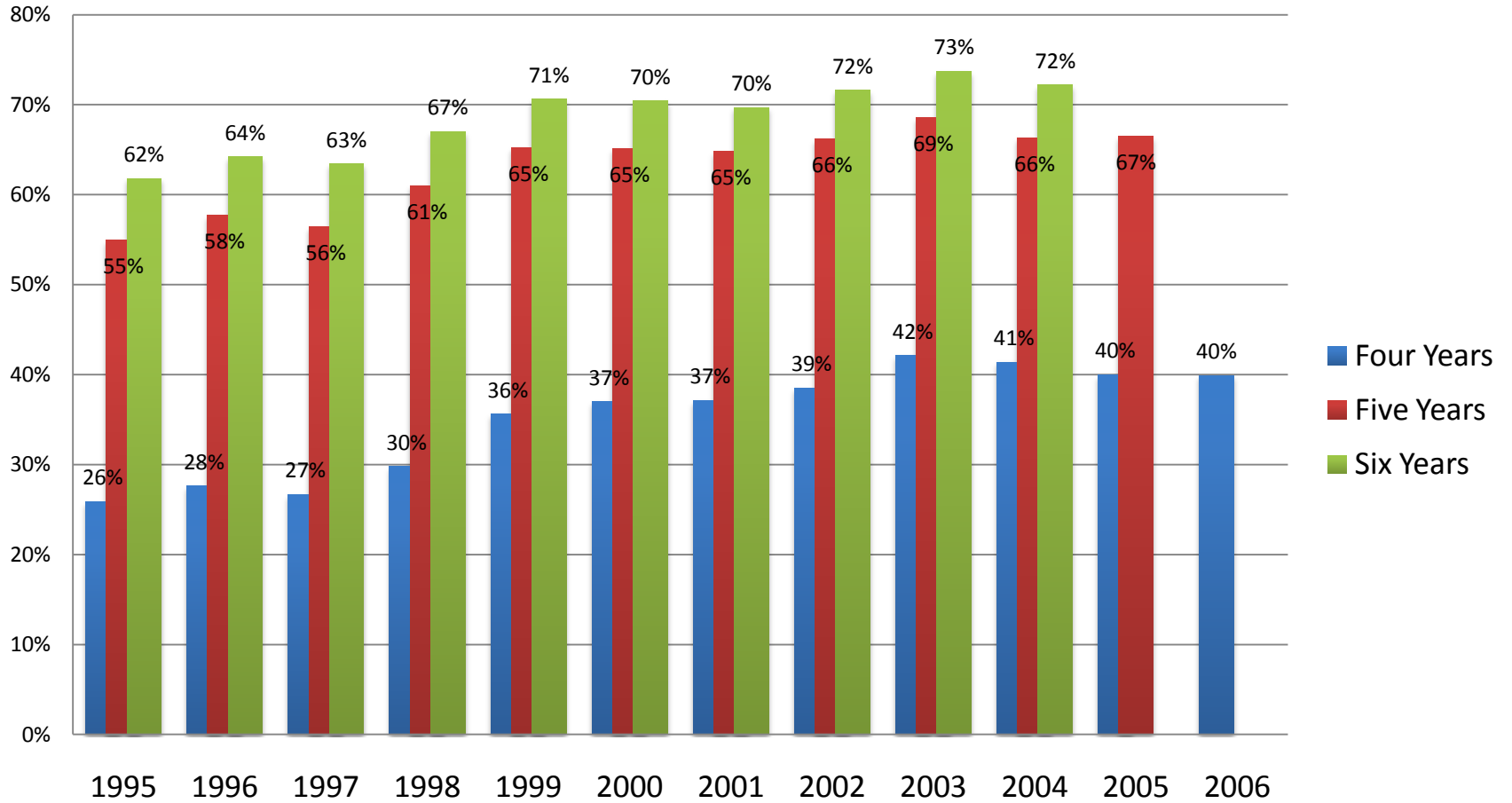


# Freshmen Graduation
