During the 2009/2010 academic year the Academic Policy Committee discussed and endorsed changes to the following regulations:

REG 02.20.3 Attendance Regulation (Changes submitted to and endorsed by the Senate)

REG 02.20.6 Course Repeat Regulation (including repeat without penalty; Changes proposed, but still under discussion at other committees)

REG 02.20.2 Adding and Dropping Courses Regulation (Changes proposed, but still under discussion at other committees)

The committee selected Tim Hatcher to be the Senate representative on the Administrative Board of the Graduate School.

The committee was informed by Jan Genzer (also attended by Paul Cousins and Judy Curry) about issues with Course Hero and similar websites publishing course materials, including tests and exam solutions. Possible remedies were suggested, addressing the academic integrity issue (a new boilerplate statement will be introduced by DUAP) and the copyright issue associated with this. Further discussion took place in the Faculty Senate and the Licensing Resource Group.
