The University Career Center is a great resource for finding and applying for internships. Whether you are interested in being a vet or a pre-school teacher, internships are available in a variety of fields. **ePACK**, the NC State student job and internship online database, is a good place to start your search. New internships are added daily. Once you've signed in, click on **Job Search** and then you can specify what job category you are interested in and click **Internship** under position type. You can also use ePACK to search for on-campus interviews and career fairs.
