- Describe your role in the project. If you will be a member of a team, describe the team and indicate your role in the context of that team.
- State your problem, argument, or hypothesis
- Describe your Methodology, Materials, and Data (How you plan to go about your research)
- What are your expected outcomes? Include plans for presentation of the work.
- Include an itemized budget with justification. Refer to the "Call for Proposal" for details.
