

University Honors Program Honors Study Abroad: Timeline

At Least One Semester Prior to Your Study Abroad Experience

- Review your Plan of Study with your faculty advisor to determine how your study abroad experience fits into your academic plan.
- Meet with a Study Abroad advisor to discover your options and choose the experience that best meets your interest and academic needs.
- Work with both your faculty advisor and the Study Abroad office to determine how your study credits will transfer.
- Complete Study Abroad paperwork and Honors Study Abroad Contract.

While Studying Abroad

- Take advantage of all educational, social, and cultural opportunities available.
- Keep in touch with both your faculty and UHP advisors.
- Take the time to reflect on your experience. We encourage you to keep a journal, take photos, and keep mementos.

Completing your Experience

- Keep in contact with the Study Abroad Office to ensure that your course credit has transferred.
- Consult your faculty advisor to ensure that your transferred course credit has been applied correctly.
- Consult your UHP advisor to ensure that your transferred course credit (up to three credit hours) has been applied correctly toward your program completion.
