

Wolf Village Apartments Accessibility

Wolf Village Apartments is the newest housing community on campus at NC State University. Our community is well suited for all individuals in the NC STATE community.

External Accessibility Features:

- The pedestrian path system has been designed to provide full access across the site without need of ramps or lifts.
- The fully accessible All Campus Path runs through the middle of the site. All buildings are accessible without the need for ramps from this route. Although not yet continuous to the main campus, the campus master plan calls for an eventual connection between the Path and the main campus.
- All site amenities, including formal and informal seating areas, volleyball courts, trash and recycling bins, bus shelters, and bicycle racks are located on accessible routes.
- There are parking spaces reserved for persons with physical disabilities within 200 feet of an accessible building entrance.
- Each accessible entrance is equipped with powered door operators.
- All public spaces are located on accessible routes, including meeting rooms, lounges, lobbies, classrooms, the convenience store, and the multipurpose fitness room.
- All public bathrooms are fully accessible, including grab bars and roll-under sinks.
- All apartments are adaptable for persons with physical disabilities, with maneuvering clearances in kitchens, corridors, and doors and provisions for future installation of grab bars.

Internal Accessibility Features:

- Fully accessible apartments are available in each of the eight (8) Wolf Village Apartment buildings.
- Each accessible apartment meets North Carolina Accessibility Code. The apartments have a side-by-side, front loading washer and dryer, and maneuvering spaces in the kitchen and bathroom.
- Each apartment has a transfer shower, and a shower seat.
- The accessible units have accommodations for the hearing impaired.
- Wolf Village also provides apartments for individuals with hearing impairment only that include strobe features for the fire alarm system.
