About the Program

Check-in is from 8:00 – 8:45 a.m. in the North Gallery, 2nd floor of the Talley Student Center, which is located on Cates Avenue. You must check in to receive your book bag and program schedule. The morning program will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. in the Ballroom, which is located on the 2nd floor. You will be introduced to the NC State academic community and support services.

You may get your AllCampus card during lunch at Fountain Dining Hall. This student identification card will give you access to multiple services, including meal plans, debit spending accounts, D.H. Hill Library, Student Health Services, Carmichael Gymnasium, and special events. You will need to bring a photo ID with you to obtain your AllCampus card.

Following lunch at Fountain Dining Hall, optional tours, escorts to campus offices, and meetings with your college or academic department to assist you in planning your spring schedule will take place. Plan on a 4:00 p.m. departure.

Cost of New Student Orientation

A Spring Entry Orientation fee of \$54 is charged to all first-year, transfer, or newly matriculated degree-seeking students, **regardless of your attendance at Orientation**. This fee is included in your tuition and fees statement. Do not send payment to New Student Orientation.

During orientation, parents and family members are encouraged to come with their students and attend Parents' Orientation. Parents' Orientation runs in conjunction with the student's program and is designed to introduce families to the academic programs and special services available at NC State. Foreign Language Placement Test

All students who need to be placed in French, Spanish, German, or Latin may go to the Language and Computer Labs, which is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. It is located on the corner of Current and Stinson Drives. The computerized test takes 25-30 minutes and the results are available immediately. What to Bring to Orientation

- Orientation parking permit, which must be displayed on your car at all times during Orientation

Parking

Orientation participants may park on campus in the Reynolds Coliseum Parking Deck located off Dunn Avenue. The deck address is **201 Jeter Drive, Raleigh, NC 27607**. Please print the Orientation Parking Permit, which is located at www.ncsu.edu/orientation/springentry. Place the permit on the passenger side dashboard of your vehicle so that Transportation officers will know you are attending Orientation. Do not park in “Accessible” spaces, metered spaces, or in a pay lot.

HOW TO GET TO NC STATE

Reynolds Coliseum Parking Deck street address is 201 Jeter Drive, Raleigh, NC 27607. Due to construction projects in and around campus, please visit the NC State Transportation website at www.ncsu.edu/transportation prior to attending Orientation for updates on road closings, etc.

From New York via I-95: Take I-95 South to Exit 138, US-64 West toward Nashville/Raleigh. Take Exit 419, US-440 toward US-1/Wake Forest. Continue on US-440 to Western Boulevard, Exit 2 toward NC State University. Pass through the sixth stop light, then turn left onto Pullen Road. Turn left onto Dunn Avenue then left on Jeter to enter the parking deck.

From Chapel Hill via I-40: Take I-40 East approximately 25 miles to Raleigh. At the I-40/Wade Avenue split, stay on I-40 East to Gorman Street, Exit 295. Turn left onto Gorman Street and follow it to the third traffic light. Turn right onto Avent Ferry Road. Turn right onto Western Boulevard and take the first left onto Pullen Road. Turn left onto Dunn Avenue then left on Jeter to enter the parking deck.

From Durham via US 70: Take US 70 to downtown Raleigh (US 70 turns into Glenwood Avenue). Continue on Glenwood Avenue and turn right onto Oberlin Road. After entering the first roundabout, take the first right to stay on Oberlin Road. Continue to the second roundabout at Hillsborough Street. After entering the roundabout, take the second right onto Pullen Road. Turn right onto Dunn Avenue then left on Jeter to enter the parking deck.

From Rocky Mount via US 64: From Rocky Mount via US-64: Take US 64 West toward Raleigh. Take Exit 419, US-440 toward US-1/Wake Forest. Continue on US-440 to Western Boulevard, Exit 2 toward NC State University. Pass through the sixth stop light, then turn left onto Pullen Road. Turn left onto Dunn Avenue then left on Jeter to enter the parking deck.

From Fayetteville via US 401: Take US 401 to Raleigh. Then take I-40 West to Gorman Street, Exit 295. Turn right onto Gorman Street and then right at the second traffic light onto Avent Ferry Road. Turn right onto Western Boulevard and take the first left onto Pullen Road. Turn left onto Dunn Avenue then left on Jeter to enter the parking deck.

From South Carolina via I-95: Take I-95 North to I-40 West. Proceed on I-40 West into Raleigh to Gorman Street Exit 295. Turn right onto Gorman Street and then right at the second traffic light onto Avent Ferry Road. Turn right onto Western Boulevard and take the first left onto Pullen Road. Turn left onto Dunn Avenue then left on Jeter to enter the parking deck.
