What do we seek to accomplish?

- **MORE COMPETITIVE RESEARCH GRANT PROPOSALS** because their diversity objectives are more fully integrated into the campus strategic plan.

- **INCREASED RESOURCES** for campus-wide diversity programs and initiatives.

- **INCREASED CAMPUS DIVERSITY.**

The Concept

How will we accomplish our objectives?

- **Partnership** between ODAAA, OIA, and ORA to hire a diversity development and grant writing specialist.
- This specialist **collaborates** with campus scientist to write more effective diversity objectives, programs, and outcomes assessment into their grant proposals.
- Part of the grant's budget is committed to the ODAAA and the OIS **for more effective** integration and implementation of the grant's diversity components.

A Pilot Project

NSF Science and Technology Center

- Multi-campus collaborative research of bioprocessing, extraction, and purification systems.
- Includes significant Educational Outreach and Knowledge Transfer (EOKT) components for historically underrepresented groups.
- \$35,000 per year for five years to ODAAA for the grants diversity programming and diversity outcomes assessment.
