Proposed wording:

Any violation that has been committed at least in part because of the victim's race, color, religion, creed, sex, national origin, age, disability, veteran status or sexual orientation shall be considered as aggravated misconduct and result in a stronger sanction.

Section 15.9 is entitled "Circumstances Affecting Sanctions" and looks like an appropriate place to add a provision on the aggravating factor of hate/bias motivation.
