-Testing Options and Costs-

Student Health Services currently offers TWO OPTIONS for STD testing.

1. FREE CONFIDENTIAL CLINIC EVERY WEDNESDAY FROM NOON TO 3 P.M.*

Please note: Not available Nov. 25, 2009, due to Student Health early closing at 11:30 a.m.

This clinic is held at Student Health by Wake County Human Services (WCHS). Appointments are made *for the current Wednesday, beginning each Monday*. Results are given at the follow-up appointment, *unless positive*. Note: Herpes and HPV testing are NOT provided by WCHS. Call 919-515-7107 to schedule an appointment. *Call early, as these appointments are limited. Last appointment is at 2:30 p.m.

2. TESTING AT STUDENT HEALTH BY APPOINTMENT

STD testing is also available by appointment at Student Health; however, there is a fee for tests and the tests become part of your Medical Record. Treatment options will be discussed with you at your visit.

HIV	\$5 State Lab	2-3 weeks

Syphilis	\$5 State Lab	2-3 weeks
	\$6 Lab Corp	5-7 days
Herpes	\$53 Blood Screen	7-10 days
	\$40 Wound Swab	7-10 days
Gonorrhea/Chlamydia	\$40 Urine	5-7 days
	\$40 Cervical Swab-female	5-7 days
Trichomoniasis, Yeast, Bacterial Vaginosis	\$14 Wet Prep-female	Same day
Genital Warts (HPV)-female (currently no test for males Other than physical exam)	\$75 Routine Pap/physical exam, plus \$72 HPV-specific testing if “abnormal” cells detected.	5-7 days
