

## Center for Transportation and the Environment Context Sensitive Solutions Summer Academy

**About the Program:** In cooperation with the North Carolina Department of Transportation, CTE conducts a unique, experiential summer program for junior- and senior-level undergraduate students interested in careers in transportation and the environment. The CSS Summer Academy introduces students to the principles of context sensitive solutions. More, it illustrates how CSS concepts are being applied at various levels of transportation planning, project development, construction, operations and maintenance. In addition to classroom instruction, students participate in field trips that showcase real-life applications of CSS.

**Program Activities:** Throughout the summer (May through August), students also work as paid interns with the North Carolina Department of Transportation. They are placed in positions that directly address environmental concerns in transportation and are required to research and write a case study related to their work assignments.
