

First Year Research Experience!

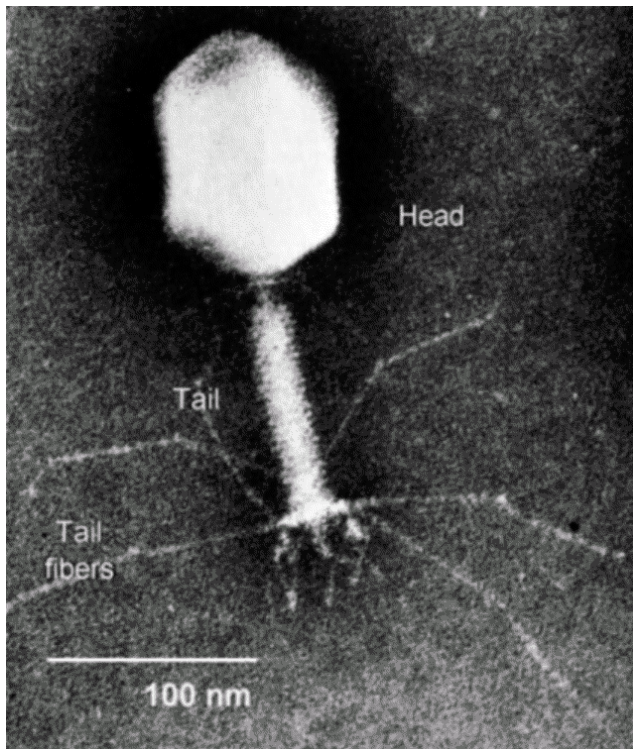
First year students are invited to participate in a new mentored research course. Students who are involved in research do BETTER in their coursework and are more likely to go on to graduate or professional school.

In the Fall semester, we will isolate novel bacteriophage (viruses that infect bacteria) from the environment and characterize by electron microscopy and other methods.

In the Spring semester, we will analyze and annotate the genome sequence of the novel bacteriophage we isolated in the Fall.

Students are asked to participate in both semesters for a complete experience.

The course is limited to 18 students, so register now!



In the Fall, register for BIT 210 or MB 210 "Phage Hunters" (whichever section has open seats available).

In the Spring, register for BIT 211 or MB 211 "Phage Genomics".
