

in forestry also, we are going to see the same kinds of things taking place in the next 20 years that we have seen in some of these countries. Where I never thought I would see a cultivation of forest trees, like in India. And despite the fact that I've spent this last 61 years in Third-World countries working on food, I continue to maintain interest in forestry and land use in its broadest context including wildlife. And those principles that I've learned as an early forester have served me well in understanding proper use of the land resource base in many countries. It's hard to transmit this to political leaders, the important role that forest cover and grass cover does to prevent erosion and also for the best utilization of that land.
